Following a consultation, the following words have been agreed by you, our Netherhall families, for our Family Charter which will be shared with all families at the start of Autumn Term 2026-27.

Thank you for all your help!

Be Kind

Families will:

Treat staff, pupils, other families and members of the wider school community with respect and understanding.

Communicate calmly, even when things feel difficult.
Support your child to show kindness in their own way.

Be Brave

Families will:

Share your worries or challenges early so we can help together.
Try new strategies or routines that may support your child's learning or wellbeing.
Attend meetings or workshops, even if things feel unfamiliar.

Be Honest

Families will:

Tell us important information about your child's needs, health, or home circumstances (only what you feel comfortable sharing – it will be treated as confidential).
Let us know if you do not understand something so we can explain.
Share honest feedback to help us improve.

Be Safe

Families will:

Follow safeguarding procedures (e.g. keeping phones in pockets when in school, signing in, supervising siblings, respecting boundaries).
Keep emergency contact details updated.
Inform us promptly about medical changes, medications, or concerns.
Ensure your child attends school regularly and safely.

Grow Together

Families will:

Work in partnership with staff to support your child's development.
Celebrate progress, big or small.

Engage with the school community through events, communication, and shared learning where you can.
Use the Evidence for Learning app to stay up-to-date with your child's learning.
Help us build a positive, inclusive environment for everyone.
